

Physical contact / Progressive Checking



M13AAA – Physical Contact

- The player and one of the parents must follow the online training - physical contact (checking 1)
- All players (except goaltenders) must follow physical contact training on ice (2 sessions)

M15AAA - Progressive Checking

- The player and one of the parents must complete the online training - progressive checking (checking 2)
- All players (except goaltenders) must complete the 2 on-ice sessions of progressive checking training.

M13AAA Elite – Physical Contact

- Players who have already completed online training (physical contact) are exempt
- All players (except goaltenders) must follow physical contact training on ice (2 sessions) even if they have completed it
- If a player has never done online physical contact training, the player and one of the parents will have to follow the training (theory and videos) on the HCR (Hockey Canada) website.

M15AAA Elite – Progressive Checking

- Players who have already completed the online training (checking 2) are exempt
- All players (except goaltenders) must follow the progressive checking training on ice (2 sessions) even if they have completed it
- If a player has never done online progressive checking training, the player and one of the parents will have to follow the training (theory and videos) on the HCR (Hockey Canada) website.
