◆ Registration Process

To register for the upcoming season, please register through your home association (Westmount, CSLMHA, or MWH hockey).

U9 level

At the **M9** level, we recognize this stage is often an introduction to hockey for many players and families. With that in mind, our goal is to form teams more locally—closer to home and within each community—rather than fully merging across associations. This allows us to maintain a familiar environment for new players, while still benefiting from the shared resources and support of the broader partnership. To ensure fairness and transparency:

- **Evaluators from each of the three associations** (Westmount, CSLMHA, and MWH) will be present at tryouts.
- Evaluators will work collaboratively to assess all players.
- Final team selections will be made with equal input from all three associations, ensuring a balanced and unbiased process.

◆ How Will Coaching and Team Staff Be Selected?

Just like the tryout process, we are committed to having equal representation from all communities on each team if possible.

- Coaching staff and team managers will be chosen based on experience, qualifications, and their ability to foster a positive and inclusive environment.
- Each team will include staff from more than one association, reflecting the spirit of collaboration at the heart of this partnership.

◆ What Uniform Will Players Wear?

For the **2025–2026 season**, players will wear the jersey of the association hosting their team:

- If the team is hosted in Westmount players will wear a Westmount Wings jersey.
- If the team is hosted in CSL, players will wear a Canucks jersey.
- If the team hosted in MWH, players will wear a Knights jersey.

Please note that we are already looking ahead to future seasons to explore alternative solutions for jerseys and team names that reflect the unified nature of this partnership while maintaining local identity.

We believe this approach will provide a stronger foundation for all players and ensure that every athlete benefits from the collective support of the **Westmount, CSLMHA, and MWH** communities.
