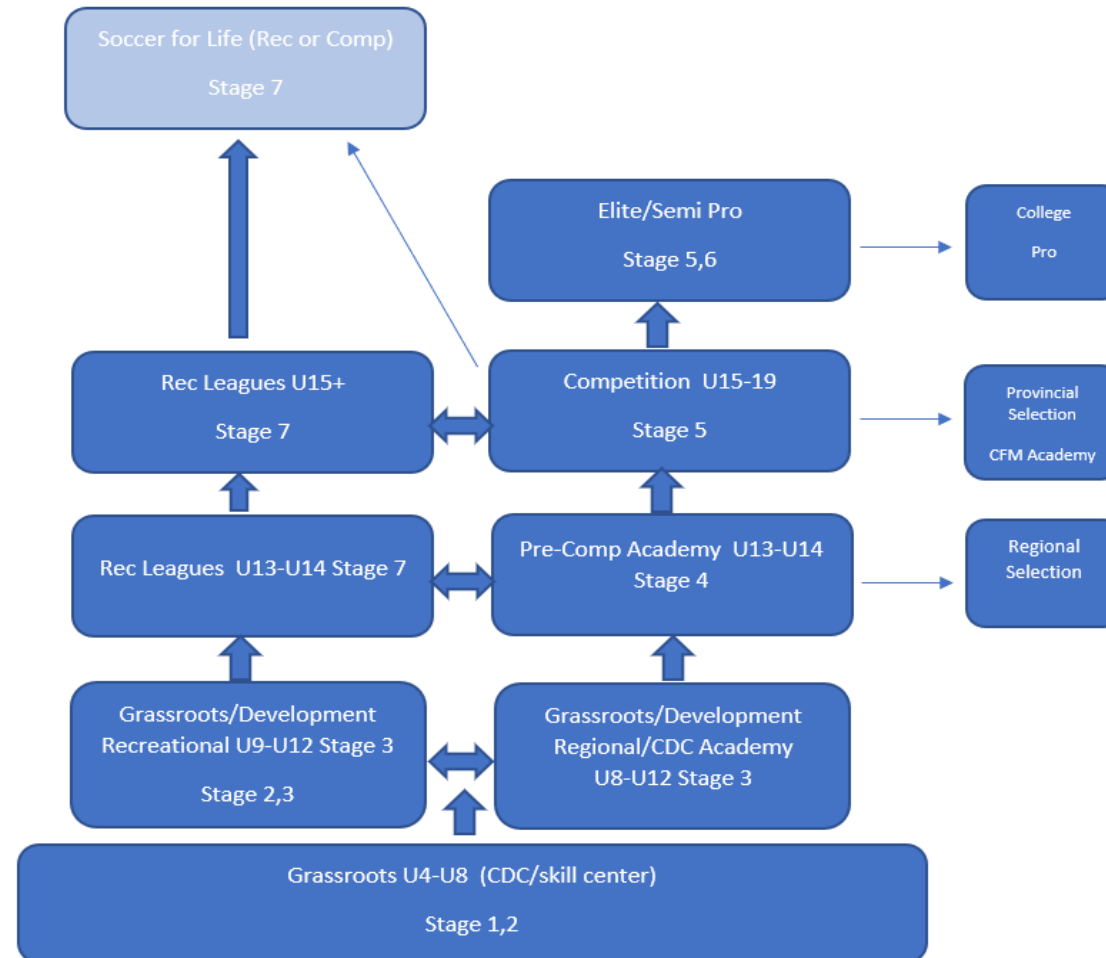

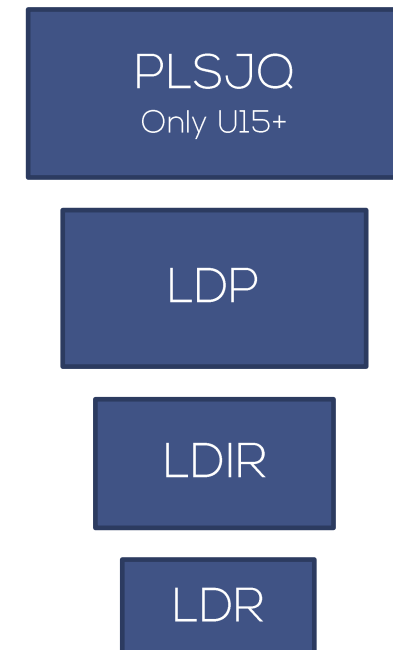

# GENERAL INFORMATION

- Provincial License=At U13+, Club can enter teams in LDP(AAA), LDIR(AA), LDR(A)
- At U13-14, no PLSJQ; everyone in LDP as highest league including national clubs. U15+ National clubs can enter a team in PLSJQ.
- U13-U14 extension of CDC; intro to 11 A side. No standings U13 LDP.
- Coaches need minimum ESP.
- Physio required at games.
- Geographic Conferences to try and reduce travel
- Player for PIR (regional program) typically from LDP.



# PROCESS

- Identification sessions in Fall (October 15/16). For U13-14, no external advertising of tryouts. Invite to current CDC players, Rec players, and outside players that have been approved. This will give an initial idea of where we stand in terms of entering teams.
- ID sessions used to see the numbers, and caliber in order to forecast 2023 teams. Players invited to winter program should have potential to play competitive but are not guaranteed a spot on a team. Players train together as an age group until teams are made in January.
- Coaches and team rosters finalized by tech staff in January. LDP? LDIR? both etc.?
- Teams train as a team February onwards.
- Team roster for 11 a side = 16-18 players.
- Player movement allowed between teams in the club (i.e., LDIR to LDP, etc.)

# WHAT LDP ENTAILS

- Possible Frequent Travel (i.e., Quebec)
- 3-4 Soccer Activities a week (i.e., 2-3 practices, 1 game, video session). **Not optional**. Attendance a must. **Soccer becomes a priority**.\*\*\*\*\*This is important\*\*\*\*\*.
- Focus, Dedication, Commitment
- Financial Commitment (approx. 1000\$, registration, team budget)
- LDIR/LDR=Regional Games=3 activities a week=approx.500\$

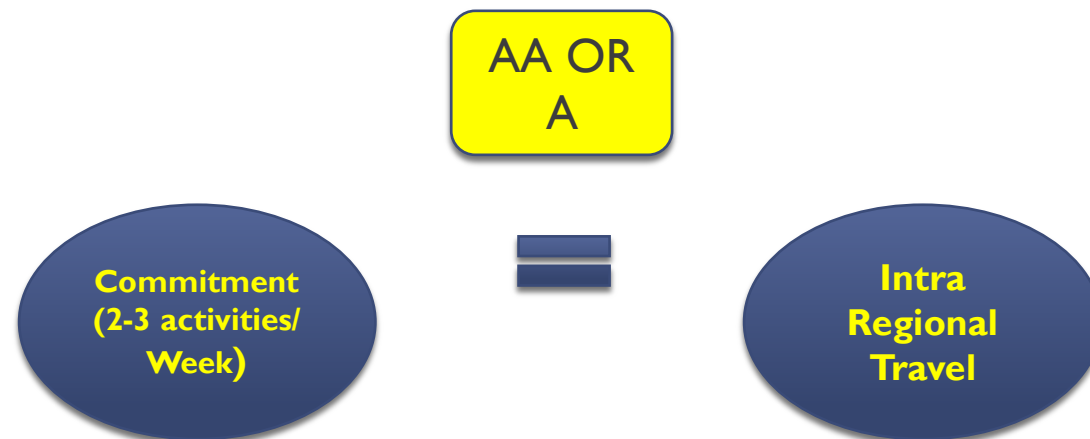
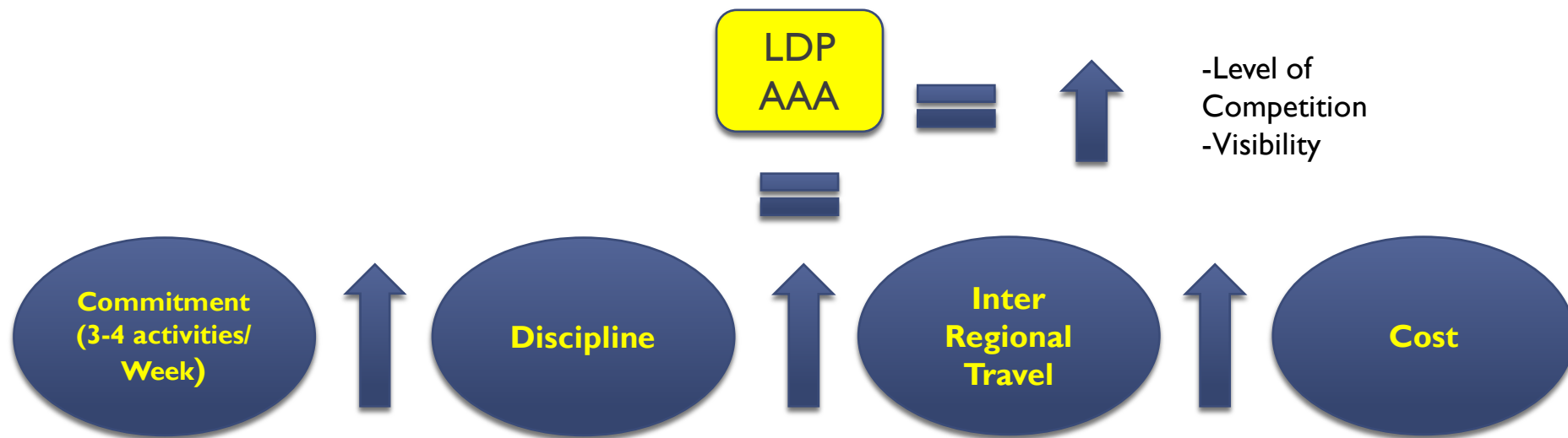

# PLAYER MOVEMENT

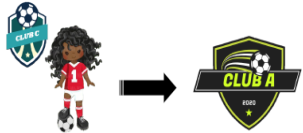
- New CSA/SQ Reform= No open tryouts at U13-U14=Limited player movement=Goal to develop internally.
- License Requirement to have below a certain of Mute players. All must be justified/documentated
- Player movement allowed by exception if:
  - A club does not offer a level and a player should be playing higher, the club can refer the player to another club. Parent/TD-TD discussion.
  - TDs discuss the player and determine it is in the players best interest to change clubs. (i.e., address change, level not offered, too many LDP caliber players, etc.)

Proper process to be followed for player movement (forms, communication)

1. Faire remplir le « Protocole de mouvement » aux parents/joueurs
  - Ce document est à conserver pour vos dossiers



2. Aviser le club de provenance par courriel que leur joueur a démontré un intérêt à joindre votre club en utilisant le « Protocole de communication entre clubs – Section A »



DTC ou Responsable Juvenile

3. Discussion avec les parents/joueurs (les questions fondamentales)
  - Poser les questions fondamentales (voir procédure U4-U12)
  - Expliquer les différents parcours/programmes
  - Expliquer les attentes et standards

Une approche centrée sur le développement de la personne avant tout.



4. Aviser le club de provenance de votre décision finale
  - Si le joueur n'est pas sélectionné sur l'équipe évoluant dans le plus haut niveau de compétition du club qui l'accueille, redirigez-le vers son club de provenance.

Process already introduced last year as seen above, now with more details including no tryouts at U13-U14. Soccer Quebec working on new updated documents
